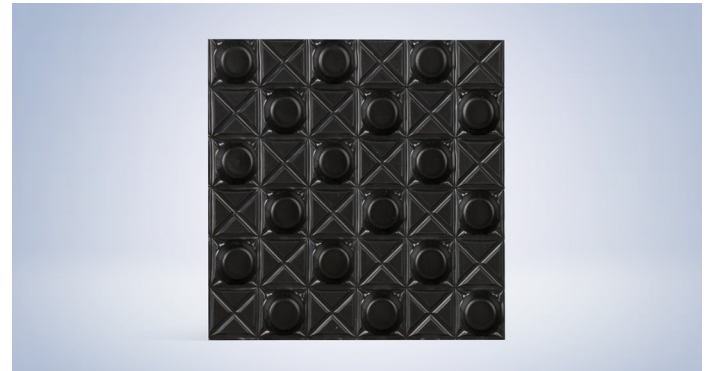


Oldroyd Xv Black Cavity Drainage Membrane

Oldroyd Xv Black Cavity Drainage Membrane is made from polypropylene and is black in colour. The membrane features a combination of embossed 'X' pattern and 7 mm studs. It is suitable for application to walls, floors and vaulted ceilings, as part of a damp-proofing or waterproofing strategy. It is fixed to walls by means of **Oldroyd Brick Plugs** and loose laid on floors.

Preparation

Repair any significant defects in the substrate. If installing the membrane to existing rendered background, this can be left in place as long as the bond between the underlying substrate and the render itself is sound.

Application

Fix the membrane to the walls using **Oldroyd Brick Plugs**. All joints to be sealed using the appropriate sealing tape. Please refer to full application guidelines or call our technical department for further advice.
